General note No.3 states contractor is to follow Detail A which provides an 18 inch section. Please advise how to proceed.

Running track -  Perimeter

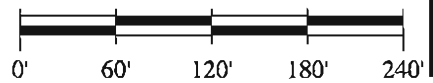

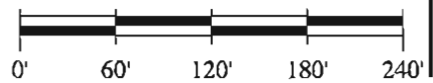
SHEET P-1: ADDITIONAL STRIPING PLAN
